The BC Cancer Agency is recruiting volunteers to participate in a study of **familial lymphoid cancer**. The goal of the study is to identify inherited genetic factors that influence susceptibility to Lymphoid Cancers

We are looking for people who:

1. Have been diagnosed with a Lymphoid Cancer and

2. Have a family history of Lymphoid Cancer

For the purpose of this study Lymphoid Cancers include:

- Hodgkin Lymphoma
- Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma
- Lymphocytic Leukemia
- Myeloma

Participation consists of:

- Answering questions regarding health and family history by telephone interview
- Providing a small blood sample (approximately 2-3 tablespoons)
- Providing contact information for first degree relatives interested in participating
